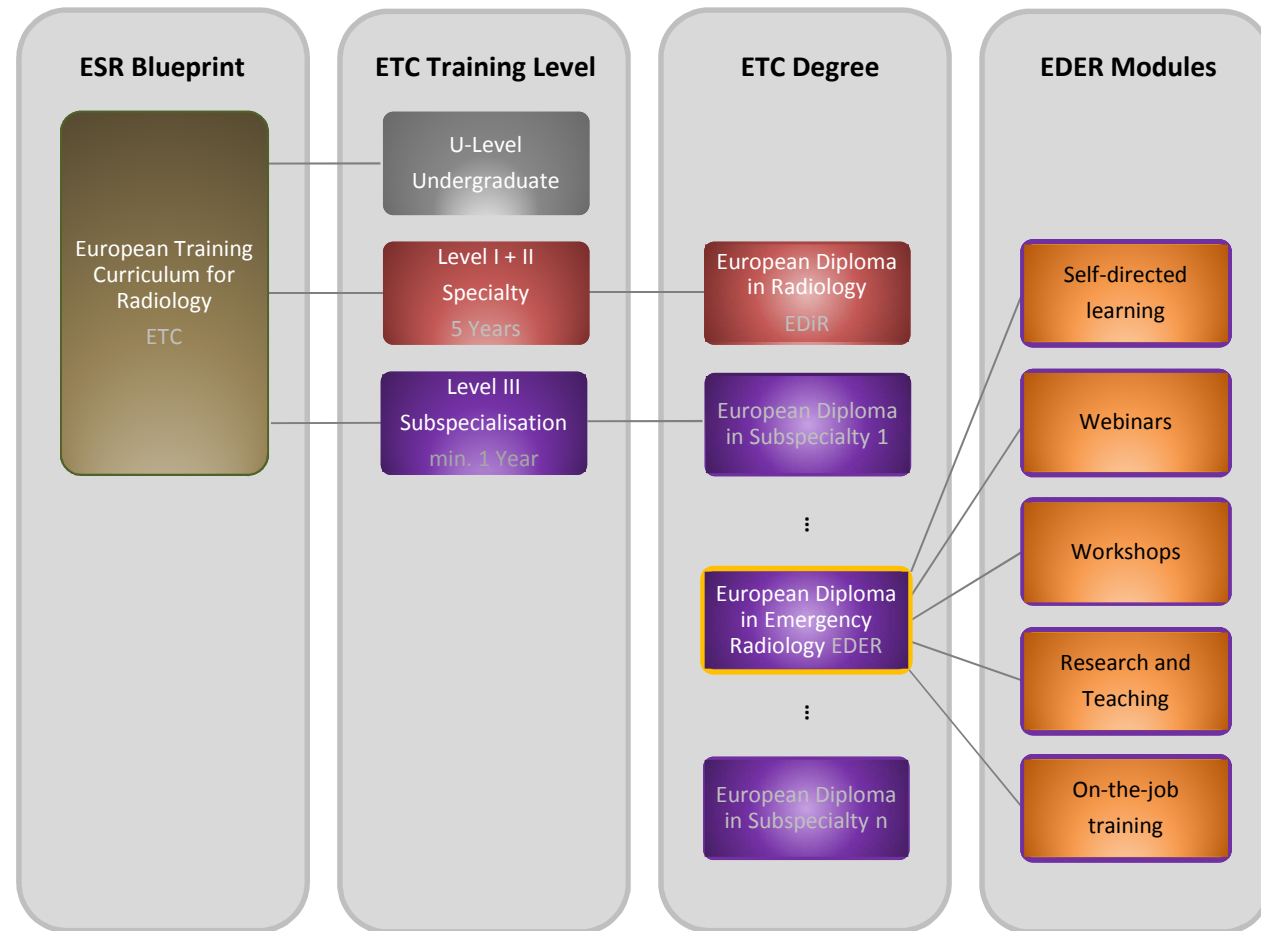
EDER at one glance

EDER	European Diploma in Emergency Radiology	
AIM	Radiological subspecialisation in European Radiology	
FRAME	ESR European Training Curriculum	
CANIDIDATES	ESER full members with at least five years of training in general Radiology	
DURATION	At least one year	
WEBINARS	11, one per month (active membership required)	
WORKSHOPS	11, five per day during congress meetings (like ECR, ESER, ...)	
EXAMINATION	Offered during congress meetings (like ECR, ESER, ...) Confirmation about achievement of practical learning goals required European Diploma in Radiology (EDiR) or national board certification required	
FEES	WEBINARS	free (only for ESER members)
	WORKSHOPS	100 EURO per workshop
	EXAMINATION	400 EURO full member/600 EUR corresponding member
	RE-EXAMINATION	200 EURO per examination
	RE-ACCREDITATION	50 EURO (every 5 years)

Topics: by anatomy

1. **Head** and brain
2. **Spine**, cord, peripheral nerves
3. **Fractures**
4. **Heart**, big vessels
5. **Intervention**, Angiography
6. **Chest** (non-traumatic, including Interventions)
7. **Abdomen** (non-traumatic, including Interventions)
8. **Musculoskeletal**
9. **Polytrauma**
10. **Special patient groups** (children, elderly, pregnant women, oncologic patients)
11. **Miscellaneous** (Drugs, quality assurance, legal bases, radiation protection, organisational aspects, communication, team behaviour, decisions between life and death)

ETC Level III structure

- Neuro / Maxillofacial / Head & Neck
- Cardiovascular and thoracic imaging
- Abdominal and genito-urinary imaging
- Musculoskeletal imaging
- Other: (a) Special patient groups (such as polytrauma, children, pregnant w.), (b) Miscellaneous (such as radiation protection, orga aspects, decisions between life and death)
